Diamond Hampers CIC has had yet another successful year and achieved some incredible things throughout that time.

The Pantry continues to be a huge success and to date we have redirected around 800 tonnes of food waste. Preventing around £600,000 worth of food from rotting in landfill. This means we have also helped prevent over 500,000kg of Co2 (PPM) from entering our atmosphere. Our waste generated an additional 670,00 meals for those accessing our store.

The Attic also continues to be a success. Through this we also supply "moving on" boxes to young people leaving care (we have so far supported over 1000 care leavers), we provide suits to support employment and continue to recycle hundreds of items of school uniform every month.

Alongside supporting thousands of people every month, we ensure we make as many grant/funding applications as possible. Along with arranging fundraising events. Through this, so far we have raised over £100,000.

Our hampers continue to address the need when people are faced with crisis. We have to date provided 425,000 meals to vulnerable people and their families. We continue to work with and for the beneficiaries to develop and implement longer term solutions that mean they no longer need to access emergency intervention and will be sustainable.

We do this by making referrals to external agencies and remain dedicated throughout the entire process to ensure the client has all the help they need in place.

Over the last year, we have helped over 800 families access this support and see them in a far better position.

In the last year, we have been honoured with 4 different awards. We received Gold for Lockdown Leader and Silver for Community Business of the Year at the Regional Business Awards. We were also honoured to attend Wembley Stadium and received two awards there also, Lockdown Leader and Business Hero at the National Business Awards.

Diamond Hampers continues to support both the people and the planet and remains for the community. Not for profit.
